Vacancy Descriptions

Membership Chair

- Responsible for comparing the membership lists from month to month and following up with members whose memberships have lapsed.
- Responsible for communicating with the President and President Elect regarding membership.
- Assist the R&S Positions with recruitment and retention of Alabama ACDA members and potential members.
- Contribute to the State Newsletter by submitting at least two tried and true pieces of literature per year (Due July 30th).
- Communicate regularly with Sundra Flansburg at Nationals to coordinate efforts and Membership Drive.
- Attend the State Summer Conference, Summer Conference Board Meeting, as well as the Board Meeting at AMEA.
- Promote ACDA events both instate, regionally, and Nationally.

State Representatives:

- Responsible for recruiting and retaining members within the area assigned.
- Communicate regularly with the President and President Elect concerns within your area of the State.
- Contribute to the State Newsletter by submitting at least two tried and true pieces of literature per year (Due July 30th).
- Attend the State Summer Conference, Summer Conference Board Meeting, as well as the Board Meeting at AMEA.
- Promote ACDA events both instate, regionally, and Nationally.

State R&S Chair Duties:

- Submit a yearly report on all R&S activities within the state, to the Division Chair on or before April 15.
- Take a leadership role in communicating with constituents.
- Communicate regularly with the Division Chair.
- Promote and organize State Honor Choirs, interest sessions, reading sessions, and roundtables at State Conventions.
- Attend State and Division Conferences and State and Division Committee meetings that are called by the State President and Division Chair.
- Submit articles and news briefs to the state newsletter. Once a year (deadline July 30th) R&S Chairs are responsible for submitting at least one article having to do with their R&S Area, as well as at least two tried and true selections with a statement about why the pieces work.
- Serve on state level audition panels for State and Division Honor Choirs and choral honor performance recordings submitted by constituents.
- Take an active part in Division Conference activities including roundtables, reading sessions, interest sessions, and assist the Division Chair with the organizing and executing of Division Honor Choirs.
- Submit web page information to your state website.
- Oversee projects that you and your state constituents deem necessary to assist in enhancing choral education in your area of R&S expertise.
- Attend the State Summer Conference, Summer Conference Board Meeting, as well as the Board Meeting at AMEA.
